

Area 3: Commonwealth Ave from Reed Ave to Glebe Rd

Description of Work

Construction will occur in two phases -Commonwealth Ave and E Glebe Rd. There may be a break in the schedule between these phases.


Commonwealth Ave

- ➤ Two 8' x 7' box culverts will be installed on the east side of Commonwealth Ave from Reed Ave to Glebe Rd
- ➤ The median will be removed and replaced with green infrastructure a natural environment designed specifically to improve stormwater runoff

E Glebe Road

One 7' x 7' box culvert will be installed on E Glebe Rd partially under the northern sidewalk

Estimated Duration of Construction



Construction Impacts



Residents at Lynhaven Apts

- ► No street parking on Commonwealth Ave
- P

 Sidewalk on the east side of Commonwealth Ave will remain open



Bicyclists – Bike lanes will be closed; bikes and vehicles will share the lane during construction



Users of 3550 Commonwealth Ave Park – Parking on E Reed Ave will remain



Northside 10 restaurant, Neighborhood Health, Auburn Cleaners, and Jet's Pizza

- Access to at least one driveway to the parking lot will be maintained
- Sidewalk in front of the property will be closed during construction



Freedom Way Missionary Baptist
Church – Access to church parking will be
maintained

Traffic Management During Construction


E Glebe Rd

- ► Two-way traffic will remain on the south side of E Glebe Rd
- ► Bike lanes will be closed; bikes and vehicles will share the lane
- ► The sidewalk on the north side of E Glebe Road will be closed
- ➤ Vehicle access from Wilson Ave to E Glebe Rd will be temporarily suspended during the construction of the culvert across Wilson Ave. Drivers will be detoured to Commonwealth Ave
- Access to parking lots will be maintained

Traffic Management During Construction

Commonwealth Ave


- ► Two-way traffic will remain on the west side of Commonwealth Ave
- ▶ Bike lanes will be closed; bikes and vehicles will share the lane
- No parking will be allowed along Commonwealth Ave (both sides) to allow for construction on the east side and two-way traffic on the west
- ► Access to parking lots will be maintained




Travel Lane
